'A wickedly funny 1911 satire on undergraduate life in Edwardian Oxford' in which the entire student body of Oxford university including the young, handsome aristocrat, the Duke of Dorset, falls hopelessly in love with Zuleika, who is visiting her grandfather, the warden of Judas college. The Undergrads ultimately commit mass suicide at the end of 'Eights Week'.

Sir Henry Maximilian "Max" Beerbohm was an English essayist, parodist and caricaturist. *Zuleika Dobson* was his only novel.
